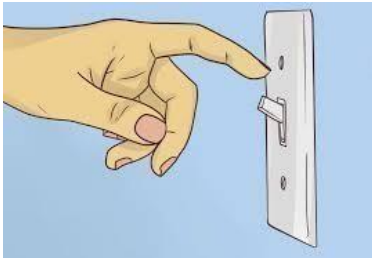


First, put water in a glass.

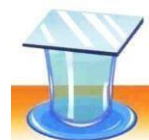
